CO2 INSTALLATION : STEP 1



- Insert the 12gm CO2 up-side down and screw back the switch end-cap.

CO2 INSTALLATION : STEP 2



- Turn the inside & outside switch end-cap clockwise together until reach the end.
- Turn the inside switch end-cap anti-clockwise about 10 degree.

Turn the whole end cap clockwise by an 6mm Allen Key
Turn all the way down, wait 1 minute for gas to fill up the mags
Use of 1 STEP END CAP

LOADING BBs



- Load BB bullet in the magazine, 6mm (23+1 rounds only)
- Please follow the illustrative sequences to load the BB bullets.

LOAD



- While loading the magazine, push it inward to the bottom till a "click" sound is heard.


UNLOAD



- Press the magazine release catch to unload the magazine.

FIRST LOAD & FIRING



- Pull the slide backward to a specific position, then release the slide forward to load the bullet in the chamber.

FIRST LOAD & FIRING




- When the chamber is load, press the trigger to fire.

DISASSEMBLY : STEP 1




- Engage the magazine release catch to release the magazine.

DISASSEMBLY : STEP 2



- Grasp the pistol with the thumb under the backstrap and the remaining four fingers on the top of the slide. Squeeze your hand like you are making a fist so the slide comes back 1/8 inch. While holding the slide to the rear, pull down the slide lock on both sides of the frame.


DISASSEMBLY : STEP 3



- Pull the slide backward and then push all the way forward until it separated from the receiver.

DISASSEMBLY : STEP 4



- Pull up on the captured recoil guide-rod assembly and lift it away from the barrel.

DISASSEMBLY : STEP 5




Remove the muzzle

- Remove the barrel by pushing it forward so it unlocks from the barrel and then lift it up and out at 45 degree angle from the slide.

LUBRICATION




Once the barrel is cleaned in the manner stated above, all that it requires is one drop of lubricant in the cam surface and one drop spread around the locking stepped portion of the barrel hood. Put one drop in each rail and stand the slide up front sight down to let it run the length of the slide rails. Use a small dab of molybdenum grease on the surfaces where there is metal-on-metal contact, like the firing pin safety punger and striker heel.

ADJUST THE HOP UP



Increase the Hop effect by turning the Hop up shield wheel towards "HOP".

SAFE



Put gun safety in "SAFE" position

FIRE



When you are ready to fire, point the gun in a SAFE DIRECTION, place the gun safety in "FIRE" position

▲ KEEP THE GUN IN THE "SAFE" POSITION UNTIL YOU ARE ACTUALLY READY TO SHOOT. THEN TURN THE SAFETY TO "FIRE".
